Our approach



Welcome to our independent, human-sized family campsite. We are ideally located between land and sea and we are committed to an approach to sustainable development and corporate social responsibility (CSR).

We carry out numerous actions for the environment and sustainable development without demands or commitment, simply through a multitude of small gestures on a daily basis. We believe this helps preserve our planet while providing a comfortable and enjoyable camping experience for everyone.

ENERGY MANAGEMENT



- We use electric carts to reduce our carbon footprint.
- In order to reduce our energy consumption, we opted for a heat pump to heat our swimming pool.
- We use low-consumption or solar-powered lighting. In addition, day/night detection cells are used for lighting paths and common areas of the campsite.
- New electrical equipment (fridge, microwave, etc.) in our accommodation is classified in economic category A or A+.
- We have set up a partnership with the community of Bray Eawy for the rental of electric bikes.
- The games at our campsite are designed for the enjoyment of adults and children, without requiring electricity.



Adopt ecological measures to save water

- We mulch our hedges, flowers and flower beds to limit watering needs.
- We have installed water savers on our faucets.
- Our toilets are equipped with waterless urinals.
- We regularly have the water quality of our swimming pools and our sanitary water checked by the ARS services.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Use of ecological products and methods for cleaning

- We opt for using a steam cleaner for cleaning
- Most of the cleaning products we use are ecolabel certified.
- Beds in the accommodations are prepared with clean linen washed with the clay stone method
- We have banned the use of disposable products




WASTE MANAGEMENT



- A sorting area with containers for glass, paper, plastics and cans is available in the parking lot.
- We grind 85% of green waste to use it as mulch for our flowerbeds and hedges, or for their natural decomposition.
- We raise awareness among our customers of the importance of selective sorting. Containers for selective sorting are available in all our rentals.
- We reuse used paper as draft paper and limit printing. We favor exchanges by email rather than postal mailings.
- We use returnable containers whenever possible at the campsite bar and restaurant.
- Your food waste should be deposited at the mini farm. Peggy, Speedy, Georges, Sidonie, and the rest of the mini farm troop are happy to meet you.







AIR QUALITY

Our establishment is committed to preserving the environment by adopting eco-responsible practices.

- Our mobile homes are not equipped with air conditioners to reduce our energy consumption.
- Our location, between the sea and the Eawy Forest, allows us to benefit from the sea breeze and the pure air of the forest.

NOISE PROTECTION

Our campsite was designed to offer a quality experience while respecting others.

- The pitches are demarcated by hedges to improve visual and acoustic comfort.
- Vehicle circulation is prohibited between 11:00 p.m. and 7:30 a.m. to guarantee the peace of mind of our customers.
- We favor electric battery tools for the maintenance of green spaces and we use thermal tools, such as mowers, only during offpeak hours when the campsite is frequented.
- We organize activities under the marquee to minimize noise pollution.



PRESERVATION OF BIODIVERSITY

- Reduction in the mowing frequency of certain areas to promote biodiversity
- Harmonious integration of equipment into the landscape
- Vegetation planted around the campsite for better integration into the environment
- Presence of insect hotels and nesting boxes to encourage local fauna
- Mulching: the grass is finely chopped and left on the ground to serve as mulch and natural fertilizer
- Preferred manual or thermal weeding
- Chickens roam throughout the campsite to help maintain the ecological balance between flora and fauna
- Resources for the recovery and revaluation of objects throughout the campsite.
